

## **Roman 8 summary of the believer's secure life in Christ**

- 1 There is no condemnation for them who are in Christ Jesus
- v2 They are set free from the law of sin and death
- v4 The requirements of the law fulfilled by walking according to the Spirit
- v5 They set the mind on the things of the Spirit
- v6 They have a mind of life and peace
- v9 They are in the Spirit
- v9 The Spirit of God dwells in them
- v10 Christ is in them
- v10 Their spirit is alive because of His righteousness
- v11 The Spirit of God will give resurrection life to their mortal bodies by His Spirit as Christ is raised in glory
- v12 They are obligated to live according to the Spirit
- v13 They are putting to death the deeds of the body
- v14 They are Led by the Spirit as children of God
- v15 They have received a spirit of adoption to be able to cry out Abba Father
- v16 The Spirit Himself testifies with their spirit that they are children of God
- v17 They are heirs of God with Christ if they suffer with Him to be glorified with Him
- v18 Their present sufferings are not comparable to the glory to be revealed to them
- v20 They wait in Hope
- v23 They groan as they wait their adoption as sons and the redemption of their bodies
- v24 In hope they have been saved

v25 In hope they persevere as they wait  
v26 The Spirit helps their weakness.  
v26 The Spirit intercedes for them with God  
v27 The Spirit intercedes for them according to the will of God  
v28 God causes all things to work together for their good  
v28 They love God and are called for His purpose  
v29 They are foreknown by God to be conformed to the image  
of His Son  
v30 God has predestined them, called them, justified them and  
glorified them  
v31 No one can effectively be against them because God is for  
them  
v32 God will freely give them all things in Christ  
v33 No charge against the elect will stand because God justifies  
v34 Christ died the them and intercedes for them with God  
v35-39 Nothing can separate them from the love of Christ  
v35 Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine,  
or nakedness, or peril, or sword?  
v36 Just as it is written, "FOR YOUR SAKE WE ARE BEING PUT TO DEATH  
ALL DAY LONG; WE WERE CONSIDERED AS SHEEP TO BE SLAUGHTERED."  
v37 But in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer  
through Him who loved us  
v38 For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels,  
nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come,  
nor powers,  
v39 nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be  
able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ  
Jesus our Lord.
