We can tell when we don't look to Christ because we get disappointed with people who are unable to satisfy our deep need for fellowship.

Deepest fellowship - Beyond understanding fellowship. The depth and the breadth of the love made possible by the power of the Spirit who brings Christ to dwell in our hearts.

Every difficulty and disappointment is a call to fellowship in His love. It is only in the light of His love that we can be His light in the world.

If we want more of God, He requires all of us. If we won't give all we won't get all.

We can tell by the condition of the horizontal plane.

for if you are living in accord with the flesh, you are going to die; but if by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons and daughters of God.

We are being sanctified by God's love testing us to identify the flesh for us to put to death, so we can become more holy and loving like His Son, in order that we can enjoy greater depth of fellowship with Him.

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
